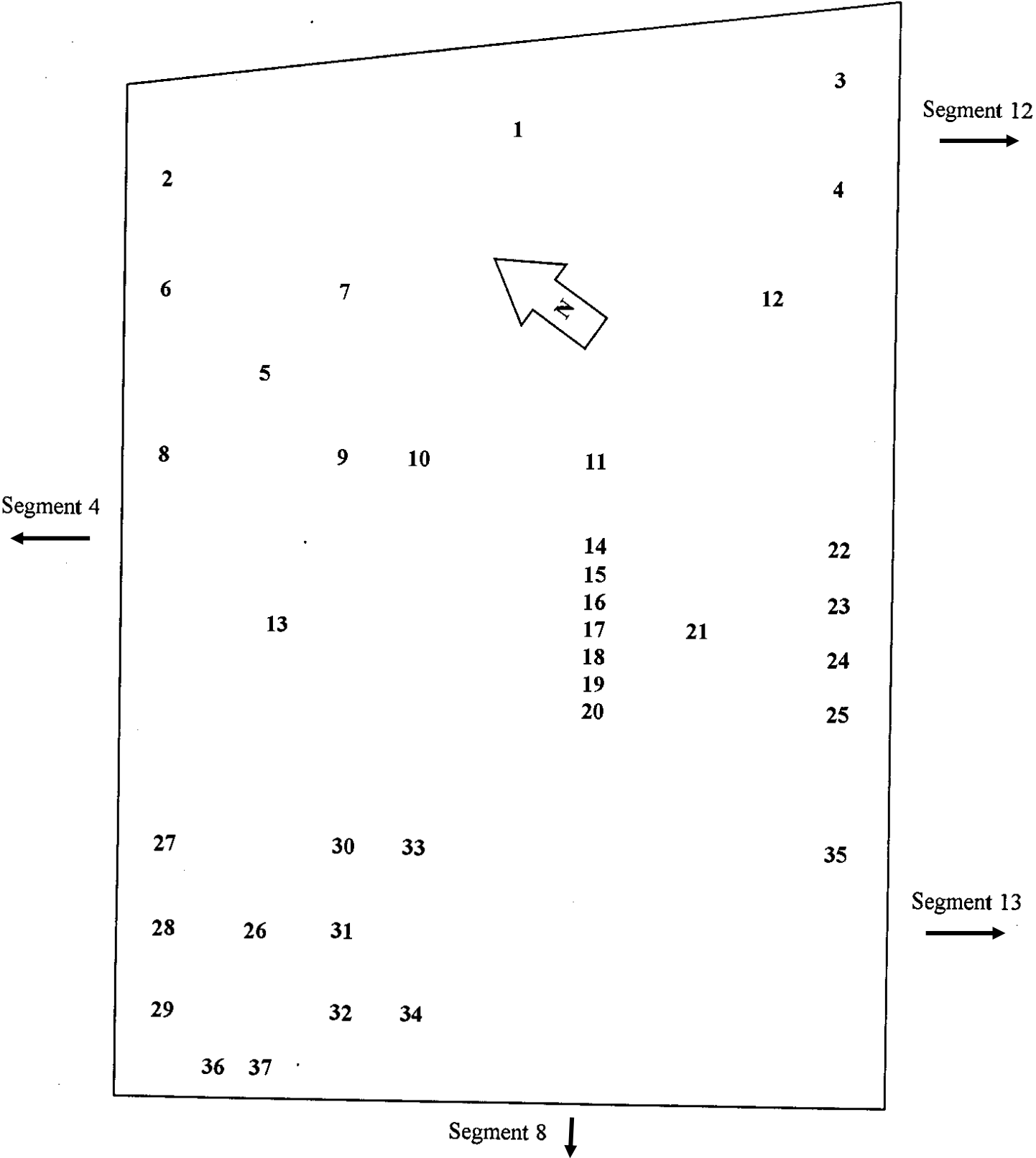

Note 1: One side of this obelisk carries the inscription “John Condict, of Norman descent, from Wales to America in 1678, d. in Newark, 1713, leaving one son, Peter, who d. 1714, his sons were Samuel, Peter 2d [Peter & Phebe], John, Nathaniel, Phillip [Philip & Mary], & Isaac. Peter 2d d. Morristown, 1768; his sons were Joseph, Nathaniel, Ebenezer, Silas and Peter 3d. Peter 3d d. 1774, leaving three sons, Edward, Byram, and Lewis.

Note 2: Although neither Silas Condict or Sarah Louisa Condict were found in The Combined Registers, their placement on the obelisk with the other children of Dr Lewis & Martha Condict suggests they too may be their children.

Note 3: This could be either Julia Elmer (Coe) Condict or her daughter Julia Elmer Condict, but it clearly is associated with the Lewis Condict Family Monument.
