Note 1: Identification is based on the inscriptions currently decipherable and the sequence provided in Parker's Survey for the Miller family markers.

Note 2: Parker's survey showed five members of the Ford family at Sites 23-26 i.e., Alfred Ford, Eunice Maria Ford, Lucretia Caroline Ford with Eliza Bishop Ford, and Jonathan Ford. Three of the four markers are sufficiently legible for identification. The remaining marker i.e., 26, is believed to be Jonathan Ford.
