**Note 2:** The numbering sequence in Parker’s Survey suggests that this is where she found the marker of Mary Lyon.

**Note 3:** Identification is based on the numbering sequence in Parker’s Survey.

**Note 4:** Unidentified markers in this segment are located at Sites 5, 46, 50, & 51. Elizabeth Beers, who had been located in this Segment, was reinterred at Evergreen Cemetery according to “Tombstones Of Evergreen Cemetery 1748 -1974” by Kemper Chambers at Page 87.
