## **SEGMENT 21 (cont'd)**

**Note 1: These sisters who died within days of each others were later reinterred at Evergreen Cemetery with their parents Alfred & Catherine Elmer (Coe) Mills, who died many years later. The displaced marker remains.**

**Note 2: Identification is based on the numbering sequence of Parker's Survey.**

**Note 3: Previously identified as being in this Segment were Eliza Pruden & Timothy Pruden. The proximity to other member of the Pruden family and the commonality of the redstone markers suggests that Eliza & Timothy Pruden may be interred at Sites 54 & 61, but the condition of the markers makes it impossible to determine which is which.**

**Note 4: There are three unidentified markers in this Segment i.e.,**

**21-12—Possibly associated with the Samuel Freeman Pierson Family**

**21-39**

**21-40**

**Possibly located in this Segment was an Infant Daughter of E.H. & E.M. Chadwick. Parker's numbering sequence would have placed the grave between Sites 18/27 & 21/12.**
