**Note 1: Parker's Survey indicates the presence of markers in this vicinity for Abigail Lindsley, w/Matthew Lindlsey; and Mary Elizabeth Lindsley and Phebe Lindlsey, both d/Abigail & Matthew Lindsley. This suggests that the illegible markers at Sites 16 & 18 could be their markers.**

**Note 2: Parker's Survey indicates the presence of markers in this vicinity for Joanna Youngs Miller, Elizabeth Day, and Ezekiel Day. The abundance of fragments in this area suggests there is another unidentified marker or markers which could be the missing markers.**

**Note 3: Several small whitestone fragments are located in this vicinity. They may have been unearthed and placed here at the time The Memorial Garden located nearby was being created.**

**Note 4: Parker's Survey indicates Jonathan S. Conplin and Phebe Cutler Howell in this area, but their graves were not located.**
